






Great TEAMWORK




**Teamwork means that

believe in each other.**






TOWER OF BABEL - GENESIS

11:1-6 (NLT)


"At one time the whole world spoke a single language and used the same words.

3 PRACTICAL STEPS FOR EFFECTIVE TEAMWORK




**1. The TEAM

Another.**




Hebrews 6:10-12




